~ TRAVEL INFORMATION ~

Climate/Weather –

By June, intermittent rain and constant high temperatures are expected throughout the country. Temperatures will range from the low 90's during the day to the low 80's at night. The rain showers help break the humidity (90%) making life a little more comfortable. Despite the precipitation, this is a very pleasant month to be in Cambodia with one great benefit being the thinner crowds at the Angkor Temples. Taking along a light rain jacket or poncho is a good idea.

Clothing Recommendations–

Pack light! Remember - lightweight and loose is the way to go! Try to recycle a few outfits during the service part of the trip. Don't forget to pack a light raincoat or parka. Clothing should be easily washed and dried. Athletic type clothing will dry faster and keep you cooler than cotton t-shirts and khaki shorts. Don't be afraid to pack articles that could be left behind.

Luggage –

Better a soft and easily transportable bag than a “wheeled” piece of luggage. A large backpack or duffle bag will work best for the in-country travel.



Clothing -

3-4 Athletic or "Quick-Dry" shirts
2-3 Light Shorts (athletic, lightweight)
1-2 Pair of khakis or casual shorts (dinner, travel, etc.)
1-2 Casual Shirts (lightweight button down or polo)
1 lightweight long-sleeved shirt or sweatshirt
1 poncho or lightweight rain jacket
Undergarments (lightweight, easy to wash and dry)
Flip-flops or sandals
Closed toed sneaker or similar for service days (comfortable and durable)
Hat
Bathing suit

Miscellaneous -

Sunscreen
Bug Spray (30% DEET) - REQUIRED!
Flashlight (small)
Toiletries
Baby Wipes
Travel Tissues
After-sun Lotion (if easily susceptible)
Hand Sanitizer
Camera
Medication (communicate with Mrs. West)
Camp Pad/Sleeping Mat (thin and light work best)

1 USD = 4,000 Hiel (This may change by the time we travel)
Cambodia does use American dollars. Bringing small bills, especially "singles" for spending money will be very helpful.
